Diabetes Prevention

Before developing type 2 diabetes, many people have prediabetes - a condition where blood sugar levels are higher than normal but not yet in the diabetes range. Prediabetes is very common, affecting about two in five adults. Most people don't even realize they have it and are increasing their risk of heart disease and stroke.

The good news! Prediabetes can often be reversed. Small lifestyle changes like increasing physical activity and making healthier food choices can significantly lower your risk.
