## PARISH NURSE

Summer often means time near the water, swimming in a community pool or boating on a favorite lake. These experiences also may include watching young children explore water for the first time. As an experienced adult, you may find yourself setting the tone for water safety.

Water safety needs change throughout life. Even strong or experienced swimmers may face challenges over time. So know your limits!

Many community centers offer safety and water classes for adults. If you learned these skills years ago, it may be time for a refresher. The same applies to cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and water rescue.

No single strategy is key to water safety. Instead, use overlapping layers of protection:

- Stay within arm's reach when children are in or near the water.
- Drowning is often silent. If you see someone struggle, act quickly.
- Don't neglect life jackets.
- Don't swim alone.
- Avoid alcohol.
- Bring a mobile phone.

Water safety works best when everyone plays a role. By staying attentive to health needs and following good habits, your time in and around the water can be safe and enjoyable.
