Staying Active for Independent Living or S.A.I.L. classes are offered at ORLC on Monday and Thursday afternoons for one hour. S.A.I.L. is a strength, balance, and fitness class specially designed for adults 65+. This is a 12-week program in which you are encouraged to attend as much as possible to help improve balance and mobility, reduce the risk of falls and improve quality of life. It is never too late to start! Participants can sit or stand and the exercises are adapted for varying levels of physical ability.
